The Agency is in receipt of your submission dated June 2, 1989 and found it to be acceptable.

1. The removal of [REDACTED] from the active ingredients in the ingredient statement is in compliance with the EPA Label Improvement Program and is acceptable. However, [REDACTED] also should be removed from the active ingredients list and included with the total percentage of inert ingredient(s).
2. Delete the statement "Total Active Ingredients 4.0%" and revise to read "Active Ingredient . . . 2.0%."
3. Delete the term "Neutral pH" from the proposed labeling because it is an implied safety claim and not acceptable.
4. Delete all phenolic coefficients from the labeling.
5. Delete the "Description" subheading from the labeling.
6. Delete the phrase "Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it" and include it in the "Storage and Disposal" section.

8. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
