PB/367 Residual Insecticide Spray

Your Application Dated November 5, 1990

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling. This letter also serves as an acknowledgement of receipt of USDA authorization for use in inedible areas of food handling establishments.

- 1. Revise the USDA authorization wording on the front panel as follows since the authorization for USDA state use in **inedible areas only**:

Authorized by the USDA for use in inedible non-food product areas of federally inspected meat and poultry plants.

Note that the Registration Standard for Diazinon was issued in December 1988 and amended on August 24, 1989. Please refer to these documents regarding the Agency's current regulatory position on diazinon, data the Agency determined to be necessary to fully characterize diazinon, revised or new labeling requirements, and compliance dates.

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Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS
AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Avoid inhalation and skin contact; wash thoroughly after using and before eating or smoking. Do not use on household pets or humans. Do not allow children in treated areas until surfaces are dry. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. For use as a spot treatment only; do not use as a space spray.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Do not apply directly to any body of water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or to residues remaining on the treated area. Do not apply when bees are actively visiting weeds or other vegetation blooming in the treatment area. Applications should be timed to provide the maximum possible interval between treatment and the next period of bee activity.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed—Call a physician immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material is taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING unless other treatment is not available. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting, give victim one or two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled—Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on skin—Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with soap and water.

If in eye—Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN. Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. Diazinon is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

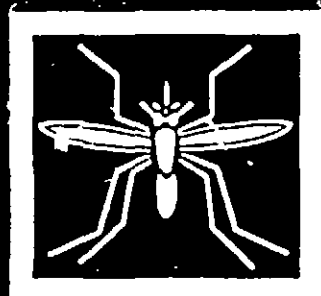
Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Store in original container only. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Residues resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in accordance with, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
