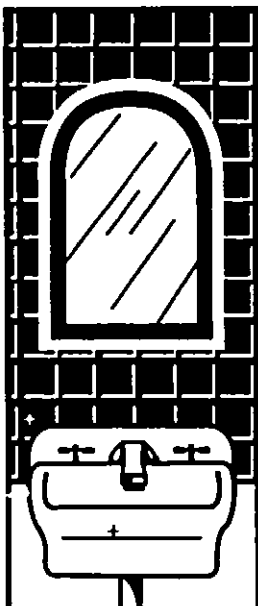
The amendment referred to above submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, to make label changes is acceptable.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product demonstrates effective disinfection against Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis, and Pseudomonas aeruginosa, thus meeting the requirements for hospital use.

This product is designed for general cleaning, deodorizing, and disinfecting in Nursing Homes, Hospitals, and Institutions. When used as directed, it is formulated to disinfect inanimate, hard surfaces (such as walls, sink tops, tables, shower stalls, and hampers). This cleaner also deodorizes areas which are generally hard to keep fresh smelling such as garbage storage areas, basements, restrooms, and other areas which are prone to odors caused by microorganisms.

**DISINFECTION, CLEANING, AND DEODORIZING:** To disinfect, clean, and deodorize hard, nonporous surfaces such as bathroom tiles, shower stalls, walls, sinks, and bathtubs:

1. Hold container six to eight inches from surface to be treated.
2. Spray area until it is covered with the solution. Allow the product to penetrate and remain wet for 10 minutes. No scrubbing necessary.
3. Wipe off with a clean cloth, mop, or sponge. The product will not leave grit or soap scum. For heavily soiled areas, remove gross soil before treatment.

**KILLS HIV-1 ON PRECLEANED ENVIRONMENTAL SURFACES/OBJECTS PREVIOUSLY SOILED WITH BLOOD/BODY FLUIDS** in health care settings (Hospitals, Nursing Homes) or other settings in which there is an expected likelihood of soiling of inanimate surfaces/objects with blood or body fluids, and in which the surfaces/objects likely to be soiled with blood or body fluids can be associated with the potential for transmission of human immunodeficiency virus Type 1 (HIV-1) (associated with AIDS). **SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLEANING AND DECONTAMINATION AGAINST HIV-1 OF SURFACES/OBJECTS SOILED WITH BLOOD/BODY FLUIDS:**

**PERSONAL PROTECTION:** When handling items soiled with blood or body fluids use disposable latex gloves, gowns, masks, or eye coverings.

**CLEANING PROCEDURES:** Blood and other body fluids must be thoroughly cleaned from surfaces and objects before application of this product.

**CONTACT TIME:** Allow surface to remain wet for 10 minutes.

**DISPOSAL OF INFECTIOUS MATERIALS:** Blood and other body fluids should be autoclaved and disposed of according to local regulations for infectious waste disposal.

**MILDEWSTAT:** To control mold and mildew on hard, nonporous surfaces (such as floors, walls, table tops), spray the surfaces to be treated, making sure to wet completely. Let air dry. Repeat application at weekly intervals or when mildew growth reappears.

**\*VIRUCIDAL PERFORMANCE:** This product was evaluated and found to be effective against Herpes Simplex Type 2 (the causative agent of the venereal disease type Herpes virus) on pre-cleaned, hard, nonporous, inanimate environmental surfaces at a 10 minute contact time.

**\*\*FUNGICIDAL ACTIVITY:** This product is fungicidal against the pathogenic fungi, Trichophyton mentagrophytes (Athlete's Foot Fungus), when used as directed on hard surfaces found in bathrooms, shower stalls, and locker rooms, or other clean, nonporous, hard surfaces commonly contacted by bare feet.

**WARNING**

Keep out of reach of children. Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, skin, or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**  
In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash all contaminated clothing before reuse.
