TO CLEAN AND DISINFECT: Flush toilet bowl by forcing it over the rim with the cleaner and wet all surfaces of bowl or urinal to clean. Allow to remain for at least 10 minutes. Rinse by flushing.

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FOR HEAVILY SOILED: For heavily soiled surfaces, use a swab mop, sponge, or brush to apply the disinfectant cleaner with two strokes. Allow to remain for at least 10 minutes. Rinse by flushing.
