Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Flying
 Direct spray in insects using spray bottle at
 secondary or treat unoccupied areas as follows:
 doors and windows. With a sweeping motion
 spray upward to all parts of the room (8 to 10 sec
 per 1000 cubic feet). Keep room closed for 15 min
 Do not remain in treated area. Ventilate area
 treatment is completed.

WASPS AND HORNETS: Direct spray at these insects
 when they are flying. Spray thoroughly into nests if doing
 breeding places when insects have settled. Allow

ants. Spray ants nests and points where they
 ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

Beetles, Sawbugs, Barklice, Bug, Centipedes, I
 wasps, Crickets, Grain Mites and Spiders. Spray in
 hidden places such as cracks, crevices,
 floor areas, openings around pipes and sinks, un
 der furniture, basements and storage areas. SE
 directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.

FOR CONTROL OF PESTS ON ORNAMENTAL PLANTS:
 control aphids, two spotted spider mites, and ad
 whiteflies on ornamental house and greenhouse plan
 (African violets, aralia, Christmas cacti, chrysanth
 mum, cineraria, dihydrochloa, lily, geranium,
 hyacinth, heath, bellis, palms, pelargonium, rose ar
 shadblow) on outdoor plants (azalea, chrysanth
 mum, euonymus, ivy, marigold, geranium, rose,
 snapdragon and zinnia). Spray plants with a fine
 sweeping motion so that mist drifts into plants. Direct
 spray so that upper and lower leaf surfaces are cov
 ered. Use caution on new growth and tender foliage.
 Repeat as necessary. When using outdoors, spray only
 in the evening.
