WB-366 Residual Insecticide Spray
EPA Registration No. 4170-50
Your Application Dated September 8, 1989

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. Revise the precautionary statements under the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals as follows:

Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Wear goggles or safety glasses. May cause contact sensitization following repeated contact with skin in susceptible individuals. Avoid repeated contact with skin. If sensitization reactions result consult a physician. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

2. The following statement must appear in the precautionary statement section of the label:

Do not apply this pesticide in the immediate area when occupants are present.

Use only in a well-ventilated areas.

3. Under the Directions For Use, add the following statement prior to the statement describing Non-food Areas:

In the home, cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils, or wash thoroughly after treatment.

4. Revise the Environmental Hazards section as follows:

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to any body of water. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate when disposing of equipment washwaters. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If on skin—Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
If in eyes—Flush eyes with water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:

Glaucoma is an ophthalmologic hazard. If symptoms of glaucoma or other conditions are present, simple saline eye irrigation is advised. WP-366 is also irritant and may be absorbed, but only in conjunction with chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
