Dear Ms. Rushton:

The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable subject to the conditions listed below:

Proposed Amendment

- Update Storage and Disposal statements per PR Notice 2007-4
- Update Precautionary Statements
- Update First Aid Statements
- Remove "Special Instructions" statement

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

- 1. Add the disclaimer, "Not for use in hospitals, nursing homes, and other medical facilities."
- 2. Change "Inert Ingredients" to "Other Ingredients".

3. Update the Storage and Disposal statements per PR Notice 2007-4. The format and language for Storage and Disposal language is provided below:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in original container, inaccessible to persons unfamiliar with its use.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide wastes may be hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste Representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

Container Handling: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling if available or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

4. Organize the FIRST AID statements in order of the most severe route of exposure. The correct order is as follows: "If on Skin or on Clothing", "If in Eyes", "If Swallowed", and "If Inhaled".

5. Change the word "porcelain" to "hard non-porous porcelain".

6. Under the product name, indicate that this is a limited disinfectant.

7. Under the Directions for Use, change both subheadings to include reference to deodorizing. Both headings must read, "To Clean, Deodorize and Disinfect..."

A stamped copy of the labeling accepted with conditions is enclosed. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals DANGER

CORROSIVE: Causes irreversible eye damage or skin burns. May be fatal if swallowed. Harmful if adsorbed through skin or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wear safety glasses, goggles, or face shield. Wear protective clothing and rubber gloves. DESCRIPTION: This product is designed for cleaning toilet bowls, urinals, sinks, bathtubs and shower stalls. It has limited disinfectant efficacy and will only kill odor causing bacteria. It removes scale, soap scum and filth.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. TO CLEAN AND DISINFECT TOILETS AND URINALS: Remove water by forcing it over the trap with swab mop. Saturate swab with disinfectant cleaner and wet all surfaces thoroughly. It is most important to swab under the rim of bowl or urinal to clean and disinfect water outlets. Allow this disinfectant cleaner to remain for at least 10 minutes until all rust, scale, and stains are loosened. Rinse by flushina.

TO CLEAN AND DISINFECT SINKS, BATHTUBS, SHOWER STALLS, DRINKING FOUNTAINS: Apply to wet all surfaces thoroughly with swab mop, sponge, brush or cloth. Rinse with water after cleaning. FOR HEAVILY SOILED AREAS: A preliminary cleaning is required before disinfection can occur. This product disinfects against odor causing bacteria only.
