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PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

WARNING

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: In case of eye contact, wash with water for at least 15 minutes and get medical attention. In case of skin contact, wash with plenty of soap and water. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This VEGETATION KILLER can be applied prior to or up to 3 months after weed emergence. Application rates vary from 1 to 4-3/4 gallons of this VEGETATION KILLER per 1,000 sq. ft. depending on climatic conditions, soil type, the weeds present and the stage of growth of the weeds. In the following rate recommendations, the higher rates are intended for use on heavier soils, where weed growth is heavy, and where rainfall is expected to be relatively high. The higher rates should also be used where longer residual control is desired in regions with a longer growing season.

For best results, apply this VEGETATION KILLER at rates recommended below prior to weed emergence or when weeds are young and actively growing.

For control of annual and susceptible perennial weeds (such as downy brome, oatgrass, goosegrass, puncturevine, goldenrod, and plantain): Apply 1 to 1-1/4 gallons of the VEGETATION KILLER mixed in a minimum of 10 gallons of water or oil per 1,000 sq. ft. to give thorough and uniform coverage.

For control of hard-to-kill perennial weeds and grasses (such as johnsongrass, bindweed, and wild carrot): Use 3-1/2 to 4-3/4 gallons of this VEGETATION KILLER mixed in a minimum of 20 gallons of water or oil per 1,000 sq. ft. to give thorough and uniform coverage.

For faster top-kill of existing vegetation, apply this VEGETATION KILLER in diesel oil, fuel oil, or weed oil. Use oils at rates of 1/4 to 1/2 gallon per 1,000 sq. ft. (100-200 gallons per acre). Tall dense vegetation, such as johnsongrass, will generally require 3/8 gallon per 1,000 sq. ft. (150 gallons per acre) or more of oil for thorough coverage.

Care must be taken to keep this herbicide away from desirable flower beds, lawns and shrubs. Do not apply over roots of valuable trees or woody ornamental plants. Only apply this herbicide outside the dripline of trees. Avoid spray drift to desirable plants.
