

- c. In the environmental hazards statement, delete the phrase pertaining to lakes, streams, and ponds, and add the phrase, "DO NOT APPLY DIRECTLY TO WATER" in its place.
- d. Refer to PR Notice 83-3 in regard to Storage and Disposal Statement.

- e. The food precautionary statement, which should be placed under the Precautionary Statement heading section, should be revised to read similar to the following:

Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. All food processing surfaces, utensils and equipment should be thoroughly cleaned with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse before using.

Remove pets and birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

INDOOR APPLICATIONS:
The use of this product in food areas should be confined to time periods when the food should be removed or covered. Surfaces should be covered before using.

Vacate treated areas and ventilate.

For maximum effectiveness, fogging is recommended.

SURFACE SPRAYING: To control crickets, clover mites, cheese beetles, spider beetles, carpenter worms, grain mites and cockroaches use coarse wet spray. Direct the spray into crevices, under pallets, around the base of machinery, behind spray bookcases. For ants, surface application only is to be applied at a rate of 1 gallon per 1000 sq ft.

SPACE SPRAYING: Close door systems. Apply with a good fog. For rapid control of flies, wasps, hornets, Angoumois moths Indian meal moths, apply at an upward angle distributing it uniformly at a rate of 3 - 6 ounces per 1000 sq ft.

FOGGING: To kill exposed insects use a rate of one gallon per 1000 sq ft. Contact insects directly.

OUTDOOR APPLICATION

ADULT MOSQUITO CONTROL: treat the entire area. For best results does not exceed 5 miles per hour where mosquitoes may rest on ponds and shore lines. Apply at 1,000 square feet).

Using truck-mounted conveyor apply at 300 feet per minute to treat a 300 foot area at 1000 gallons per minute.
