The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the product label is enclosed for your records.

1. Delete the declaration "Petroleum Distillate" from the active ingredient statement and combine this percentage with that for the inert ingredients. Do not list petroleum distillate separately.
2. Under the PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS heading, expand the statement to read "In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food or food processing equipment during application."

The label reference "Authorized by the USDA for use in federally inspected meat and poultry plants" is acceptable.

Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed—Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
If on skin—Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in eye—Flush eye with water. Call a physician immediately.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Store below 118° in original container. If spilled, mop up or otherwise absorb and hold for disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide spray mixture or residue that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to Federal, State or Local procedures under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.
