PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. May be absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing of spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling and before smoking or eating. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover all service and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. All food processing surfaces, utensils and equipment should be thoroughly cleaned with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse before using. Remove pets and birds, and cover fish aquaria before spraying.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. **DO NOT APPLY DIRECTLY TO WATER.** Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not apply where weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed—Call a physician or Poison Control Center for advice. Bring out or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin—Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. If in eyes—Flush eyes with water. Call a physician immediately.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not mix with water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Store below 10° in original container. If spilled, mop up or otherwise absorb and haul for disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide, spray mixture or residue that cannot be used according to label instructions may be disposed of according to Federal, State or Local procedures under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL
