DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label directions.

To operate, hold can upright, direct orifice toward the actuator button. Do not use as a space spray.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

To kill *Ants, Carpet Beetles, Centipedes, Cockroaches, Firebrats, Pillbugs, Silverfish and Spiders*; thoroughly treat areas where these pests are found or may hide, including closets, cracks and crevices, under carpets, along baseboards behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and other plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven away should be sprayed directly. Spray ant trails, nests and points of entry.

To kill *Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks*, Indoors: Conduct spot treatment. Spray an inconspicuous area of furniture to test for possible staining or discoloration. Spray the entire floor area. Spray should be given to cracks, crevices and under carpets. In sleeping quarters, closets, upholstered furniture (wicker, etc.) under sofas and other furniture. In animal sleeping quarters, or replaced with fresh bedding. Do not use in nurseries. DO NOT TREAT ANIMALS WITH THIS FORMULATION. Pets must be treated simultaneously with an E.P.A. approved flea and tick product on animals. Application should be repeated as necessary to avoid contact with treated surfaces (rugs, upholstered furniture, etc.).

To control: *Flies, Gnats, Hornets, Mosquitoes, and Yellow Jackets*; use only on outdoor surfaces. Spray door frames and other areas where these pests may congregate. Repeat treatment when necessary. Treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.

APPLICATION OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS OTHER THAN AS A SPOT TREATMENT IS NOT PERMITTED.

Application within food handling establishments (PI) in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared for consumption, or areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, etc.), foods, edible waste storage and enclosed processing areas (e.g., syrups) and serving areas (where food is exposed to air) is not permitted. Do not use for crack and crevice treatment in and around both food and non-food areas. Do not use on cockroaches, crickets, silverfish, spiders and waterbugs.

Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices, in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floor, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases. Do not use this product in conduits, motor housings, junction or switch boxes because of possible shock hazard. If there is a need to treat such areas, use only oil-base sprays. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food and food processing surfaces.

Application Within Food Serving Areas (Facilities where foods are served, such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held): Apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces, such as baseboards, under elements of construction and into cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. (Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed).

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Do not transport or store below 32°F.

DISPOSAL: Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and dispose of in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid skin and eye contact. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried.

Do not spray air in rooms or use on plants. Apply as a surface spray only.

Do not allow spray to contact food, feedstuffs or water supplies. Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in food serving areas while facility is in operation or food is exposed. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handling utensils contaminated with this product.

Remove pets and cover fish bowls before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS
