DIRECTIONS FOR USE
It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For control of insects in institutions, food processing plants, restaurants, food handling establishments, industry, schools, motels, and holes SHAKE WELL REFORE USING. To operate hold can upright, direct orlice toward the surface to be treated and

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. To operate hold can upright, direct orifice toward the surface to be treated and press the actuator batton. Do not use as a space spray.

TO KILL: Ants, carpet heeties, confleedes, cockroeches, crickets, earwige, firebrats, pillbuge, silverfish, and spiders; thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to areas where these pasts are found or may hide.
