On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c) (7) (A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/ reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c) (5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. Make the following label changes:
 - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 4170-81".
 - b. Add the statement "In hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment".
 - c. Remove the statement "Authorized by the USDA for use in federally inspected meat and poultry plants." After receiving authorization from the U.S. Department of Agriculture, you may submit a request to amend the registration to include this label language.

- d. Revise the Directions for Use Outdoors to Kill Flying Insects to read:

"Hold container 18 to 24 inches from shrubs, bushes, and grassy areas and spray with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from treated areas. Spray only when air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary

- e. Remove the statement "Insecticida para uso dentro o afuera del edificio". Foreign language text is only permitted in its entirety on the product label. If you wish to include a full foreign language text of this label, you submit by notification (consult Pesticide Regulation Notice 95-2) a copy of the foreign language labeling. The foreign text must be a true and accurate translation of the English text. Please be advised that if the foreign text is inaccurate or goes beyond the reviewed and accepted English labeling, the certification on record is the evidence that will be used by the Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance to take the appropriate enforcement action under 40 CFR 156.10(a)(3).

3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:
It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling FOR USE IN AND AROUND HOTELS, MOTELS, FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS, OFFICES, SUPERMARKETS, RESTAURANTS, AND HOSPITALS.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING: Remove protective cap. Aim spray opening away from person. Push button to spray.

INDOORS: For House Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Flying Nettle, Fruit Flies and Vinegar Flies: Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle upward; direct the spray mist to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated room. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed. For Cockroaches, Earwigs, Grain Moths, Silverfish, Spiders, Centipedes, Millipedes, Fleas, Ants, Earwigs, and Crickets: Spray thoroughly and frequently into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, moist areas, and other points of entry. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS: To Kill Flying Insects hold container 18 to 24 inches from shrubs, bushes, and grassy areas and spray with a slow sweeping motion while moving away from treated areas. Spray only where it is still. Repeat as necessary.
