

Apply 4 - 5 coats of finish in thin, uniform coats using a clean, synthetic mop. Allow to dry thoroughly between coats, usually 20 to 30 minutes. NOTE: If tile is old, worn, or porous, initially applying 1 - 2 coats of a sealer/base coat will enhance gloss and long term performance.

ROUTINE MAINTENANCE: Sweep large debris and dust mop (using water-based dust mop treatment). Damp mop or autoscrub using a neutral pH oleaner or disinfectant. High-speed but, or burnish as distribit. Use of restorer will prolong the time between scrub and recoat cycles.

SCRUB AND RECOAT: Sweep large debris and dust mop (using a water-based dust mop treatment). Deep scrub using a heavy-duty cleaner to remove ground in dirt and discoloration. Rinse thoroughly with clear water and allow to dry. Apply 1 - 2 coats of finish in thin, uniform coats using a clean, synthetic mop.
