DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR PEANULE: Apply at the rate of 20-30 lbs. per acre to control Thrips, Leafhoppers, Cucumber Beetles, Bean Leaf Beetle, Velvet Bean Caterpillar, Corn Earworm, Armyworm and Leaf Spot Disease. Can be used up to day of harvest. Apply 3 to 5 applications First application last week in June, or not later than July 10; following applications at 14 day intervals.
