DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Begin applications before diseases appear.

POTATOES: To control Colorado Potato Beetle, Leafhopper, Flea Beetle, Early and Late Blight: Dust at the rate of 85 to 40-16s, per acre, depending on size of plants and severity of insect and disease conditions. Apply dust thoroughly to upper and lower leaf surfaces. Reneat applications at 7-10 day intervals.

TOMATOES: To control Tomato Fruitworm, Flea Beetle, and Early and Late Blight — Dust at the rate of 30 to 35 fbs. per scre. Repeat applications, if necessary, at 7-10 day intervals. Can be applied the day of harvest

CUCUMBERS AND SUMMER SQUASH: To control Stripped and Spotted Cucumber Beetle, Squash Bug, Flea Beetle, Pickleworm, Melonworm, Downy Mildew, Anthachose, Bacterial Wilt and Alternaria Leaf Spot — Dust at the rate of 30 to 35 lbs. per acre. Repeat applications, if necessary, at 7-10 day intervals. Can be applied the day of harvest.

PEPPERS AND EGGPLANT: To control Cercospora Leaf Spot on Paggers and Alternaria on Eggplant: Dust at the rate of 30 to 35 lbs. per acre. Repeat application, if necessary, at 7 to 10 day intervals. Can be applied the day of harvest.
