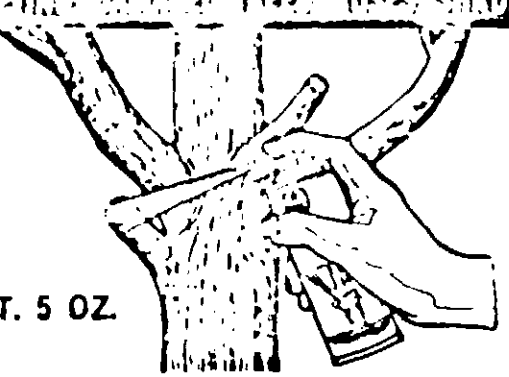

PRUNING PAINT

EASY TO USE FOR PRUNING AND SEALING WOUNDS ON TREES AND OTHER ORNAMENTALS

Asphalt, Solids	21.5%
Petroleum Distillates	28.5%
INERT INGREDIENTS	50.0%

Pruning Paint No. 4185-311 is easy and fast to use for healing pruning cuts, galls and abrasions on woody plants and trees. It provides a protective coating against the entry of moisture and wood rotting diseases. Also acts as a barrier against sap flow and wood boring insects.

DIRECTIONS: Shake well before using. Hold bomb in upright position with nozzle pointing at wound, 6 or 8 inches away from wound to be sprayed. Push button and spray.

ROSES: Since most rose wounds are small and the stalk of the rose is small, it is recommended that the paint be sprayed on a piece of paper and applied with a small brush or stick to the cut end of the rose.

TREES AND OTHER ORNAMENTALS. Treat all cuts and wounds over an inch in diameter.

CAUTION: Do not apply to humans, pets or birds. Harmful if swallowed. Warning, contents under pressure, do not puncture or expose to high temperatures, it may cause bursting.

Keep away from fence and sidewalks as the material may stain. Do not store near heat or open flame. Keep at room temperature, away from direct sunlight, radiators, stoves, hot water and other heat. Never throw container into open incinerator.
