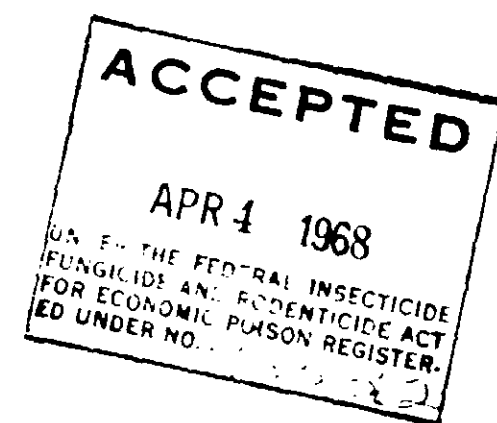

DIRECTIONS

NUTRO CRABGRASS ELIMINATOR is recommended for pre-emergence control of annual weed grasses,  
such as crabgrass (smooth and hairy) foxtail, barnyardgrass, in newly seeded or established  
plantings of the following grasses only: bluegrass, fescue, redtop, smooth brome, perennial,  
ryegrass, orchardgrass, and the following strains of bentgrass: Penncross, Seaside, Highland,  
Astoria, Minisila, C-1, C-7 and C-19.

DO NOT USE ON OTHER BENTGRASS STRAINS NOR ON BERMUDAGRASS AS INJURY to turf may result.  
The effect on golf course greens may vary with turf management practices and environmental  
conditions: therefore, it's use on golf course greens is not recommended, as injury to turf  
may result. Treatment will not control annual bluegrass (Poa annua), clover, or most broad-  
leaf weeds.

At least 1/2 inch of water must be provided by rainfall or irrigation within 3 days after  
treatment in order to carry the chemical into the root zone of germinating weeds.

### SPREADER SLIPPINGS

ANOTHER THING TO USE -  $\Delta H_{\text{vap}}$  of a liquid.

**NEW SPREADING** - Apply 1 LITRO BARCAPASS 25 EMULSION turf food at time of seeding, before or after seeding. Grass seed can be mixed with this product and both applied at the same time.

NOTE: Use only on turf areas; do not apply to crops used for food or feed purposes.
