

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply this material to plants or control that mixes readily with water for use in the control of insects attacking cotton.
For control of aphids, trips and leafhoppers, use 1 quart per acre of this material mixed with water to give good coverage.
For mid and late season control of boll weevil, bollworm, trips, aphids, leafhoppers, lygus and other plant bugs and leafworm, use 1 to 1 1/2 quarts per acre of this material in sufficient water to give good coverage.
For control of trips and leafhoppers, use 1 to 1 1/2 quarts of water per acre consistent with good growth and good coverage.

USAGE CAUTION

The active ingredients of this material should not be grazed by dairy or beef animals. Do not feed trash from treated cotton to such animals. Do not use this material for packing. Workers entering fields on the day of application should wear protective clothing. Not for use or storage in or around the home. Do not allow this material to drift onto neighboring crop or non-crop areas or use in a manner that causes drift into such areas with directions. Excessive residues or drift may cause plant injury.
