COTION: To control Thips, apply at the rate of 10 lbs. per acre. To control Bolt Weevils, Bollworms, Fleahoppers, Cutworms and Red Spider Mites, make 4 applications at 15 lbs. per acre beginning at 8 leaf stage. Resume applications on July 24 at 15 lbs. per acre, at 5 day intervals, until plant stops squaring. Do not pasture dairy animals or animals being finished for slaughter in treated fields. Do not apply within 5 days of hand picking. When necessary to enter treated fields within 24 hours after treatment, protective clothing should be worn.

DANGER

MAY BE FATAL IF SWALLOWED, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Rapidly absorbed through skin! Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles. Keep all unprotected persons out of operating areas or vicinity where there may be danger of drift. Vacated areas should not be re-entered until drifting insecticides and interesting have dissipated. Workers entering a treated field within 5 days of an application should wear protective clothing. Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs.

IF SWALLOWED—Give tablespounful of salt in glass of warm water. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have victim lie down and keep quiet

INHALATION—Remove patient from contaminated atmosphere

SKIN-In case of contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin thoroughly with soap and water

EYES-In case of contact, flush immediately with water to at the time nutes.

INFORMATION FOR PHYSICIAN (Treatment)—Give atropine preferably by injection, grain 1.30 to 1.15 (2 to 4 mg) at once and every hour or offener as needed to achieve and maintain full atropinization. Never give morphine. Clear chest by postural drainake Artificial respiration or oxygen administration may be necessary. Of erve patient continuously for 48 hours. 2 PAM is also antidotal and may be administrated in conjunction with atropine.
