

DIRECTIONS

Adjust pool water pH to 7.2 - 7.6

BEGINNING OF SEASON: Use 3 lbs. Barcolene's Pool Conditioner per 10,000 gallons of water. No more necessary unless pool is emptied and refilled. Add 4 pool pills per 2000 gallons of water until the chlorine demand of the water is satisfied as shown by the presence of a chlorine residual of 1.0 to 1.5 ppm.

BALANCE OF SEASON: Use one pill per 2,000 gallons of water daily or as needed to maintain 1.0 ppm chlorine residual as determined by a suitable chlorine test kit. However, occasionally (every 3 - 4 weeks) you should super-chlorinate by adding four Pool Pills per 2,000 gallons of water.

IMPORTANT: Place Pool Pills in the skimmer basket, a float feeder or hypochlorinator because contact with the pool inner surfaces may produce bleaching under certain conditions.
