BARCOLENE BLEACH—DIRECTIONS FOR USE

DO NOT USE ON SILK, WOOL,
MOHAIR, LEATHER, SPANDEX
(LYCRA) OR NON-FAST COLORS.

FABRICS:

Perfect for white & colorfast articles, made of cotton, linen, rayon, nylon, rayon, polyester or any mixture of these fibres.

STAIN REMOVAL:

Coffee, tea, mustard, ink, fruit, collar dirt, grass, dirt, mildew, diaper stains, vegetable, chocolate, catsup and most other types can be removed with normal washing. Procedure: Pre-soak stubborn stains such as egg, milk, or blood in a hot sudsy solution of 1/4 cup bleach per gallon of water for 5 minutes, then follow with regular washing.

MACHINE LAUNDERING:

Follow washer directions for automatic bleach dispensing. All others use Barcolene Bleach as follows: Top-loading machines—1 cup per load. Front-loading machines—1/2 cup per load. Add to wash water before laundry is put in. If laundry is put in before wash water, DILUTE BLEACH IN ONE QUART OF WATER and add after clothes are agitated and thoroughly wet. (About 3-5 minutes.)

HAND LAUNDERING:

Use 1/8 cup Barcolene Bleach to every 2 gallons of water. Mix thoroughly before adding wash.

BLEACH TEST:

Pre-test all doubtful fabrics before laundering. Soak inconspicuous area for 5 minutes in solution of 1 tbsp. bleach to 1 gallon of hot sudsy water.

CAUTION:

HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED. SKIN AND EYE CONTACT MAY CAUSE SEVERE IRRITATION. AVOID CONTACT WITH SKIN AND EYES. FLOOD WITH PLENTY OF WATER, IF SPRAYED IN EYES OR SKIN.

FIRST AID:

IF SWALLOWED FEED MILK, OR WHITE OF EGG OR COOKED CEREAL. CALL A PHYSICIAN. DO NOT USE BARCOLENE BLEACH WITH AMMONIA OR TOILET BOWL CLEANERS. HAZARDOUS GASES WILL BE RELEASED. DO NOT TRANSFER TO FOOD OR BEVERAGE CONTAINERS.

KEEP TIGHTLY CAPPED IN A COOL PLACE IN UPRIGHT POSITION.

CLEANING & DISINFECTANT USES:

KITCHEN & BATHROOM: For cleaning, disinfecting and deodorizing. Sinks, refrigerators, stoves, bathtubs, basins, tile, woodwork, wash first, then wipe down with mixture of 3/4 cup bleach per gallon of warm water. Rinse off. DO NOT USE ON STEEL, ALUMINUM, SILVER, CHIPPED ENAMEL. NEVER APPLY WITH NATURAL SPONGE.

SICK ROOM EQUIPMENT & DISHES:

Wash well, then soak in solution of 3/4 cup of bleach per gallon of hot water for 5 minutes. Rinse well, drain & dry.

DISHES: Same procedure as above but with 1 tbsp. per gallon of hot water.

SPECIAL DISINFECTING USES:

For Restaurants, Taverns, Soda Fountains, Dairies, 1 oz. or 1/8 cup of Bleach per 2 gallons of water. This is a recommended standard disinfecting solution by many Public Health Departments. **MAKES SOLUTION 200 PPM AVAILABLE CHLORINE.**

TOILET BOWLS: Clean, flush, pour in 1/2 cup of bleach. Swish around inside. Let stand 10 minutes, then flush again. DO NOT USE WITH TOILET BOWL CLEANERS OR AMMONIA! Cannot harm septic tanks.

DIAPER & BABY CLOTHES:

For growth control against many disease causing germs, USE Barcolene Bleach both in soak solutions and in normal washing cycle. Prior to laundering, rinse out soiled diapers. Pre-soak in diaper pail in a solution of 1/8 cup bleach to 2 gals. of water to reduce odor.

SWIMMING POOLS: To make the water hygienically cleaner. Will not harm plastic pools. Use 28 oz. (3 1/2 cups) Bleach to each 10,000 gallons of new water. Test water frequently and add Bleach as required to maintain 0.5 to 1.0 P.P.M. Available Chlorine. Thoroughly mix Bleach in 20 parts water and feed solution through a chlorinator, or dilute and scatter over surface of pool.



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
