All of the above beneficial activity - mildew protection, sanitizing, residual self sanitizing and bacteriostatic - occur when the fabric is treated as directed.

D-775 MILDEW PREVENTATIVE is economical to use because it is concentrated. It should be handled with care.


DANGER:
