) The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

a. Revise the heading "Directions" to "Directions for Use", and include the following misuse statement directly below it to read: "It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling."

b. On the right side panel, above the word "Danger", include the following precautionary statements:

Precautionary Statements
 Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

c. Revise the heading "First Aid" to "Statement of Practical Treatment".

d. Under "Note to Physician" delete the sentence beginning with "Measures against circulatory ... needed."

f. Revise the "Storage and Disposal" statements to read:

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in a cool place away from oxidizing or bleaching agents. Use from original container and keep covered when not in use.

Container Disposal:

Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse empty container with water. Return empty container then offer for recycling or conditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or by other procedures approved by State and local authorities.

Pesticide Disposal:

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

g. Include the heading "Physical Chemical Hazard" above the statement "Keep away from sparks, heat, and open flame".

h. Revise the referral statement to read:

" See side panel for additional precautionary statement."

i. On the center panel, remove "Net Contents, and place below the signal word and the child hazard warning statement.


2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
