- Purpose** This submission includes revised labels to comply with the Risk Mitigation Decision (RMD) of May 28, 2008, under sec 3 of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA).
- Label** The labeling submitted with the above letter is acceptable, provided you submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling to us, before you ship your product.
- Note** Should you wish to add a reference to the company's website on your label, please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. - Any person may use existing stocks of this product with the previously approved label until such stocks are exhausted.


Consequence for non-compliance

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Environmental Hazards

This product is extremely toxic to mammals and birds. Dogs, cats and other predatory and scavenging mammals and birds might be poisoned if they feed upon animals that have eaten this bait. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Runoff also may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in water adjacent to treated areas. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wash water or rinsate.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ THIS LABEL: Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions. Use only for the sites, pests, and application methods described on this label.

IMPORTANT: Do not expose children, pets, or other nontarget wildlife animals to rodenticides. To help to prevent exposure:

1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and pets.
2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and nontarget wildlife, or in tamper resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six year of age, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from stations when lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hooved livestock, raccoons, bears, or other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.
3. Dispose of product container, and unused, spoiled, and unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

NOTE: Bait stations are mandatory for outdoor, above-ground use. Tamper-resistant bait stations must be used if children, pets, non-target mammals, or birds may access the bait.

USE RESTRICTIONS: This product is only for control of Norway rats, roof rats, and house mice in and around homes, industrial buildings, commercial, agricultural, and public buildings, and similar man-made structures. May also be used in transport vehicles (ships, trains, aircraft) and in and around related port and terminals. Do not apply farther than 50 feet from buildings. Do not use in edible product areas of food or feed processing plants or other areas where food and feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not contaminate food/feed or food/feed handling equipment or place near or inside ventilation duct opening. Do not broadcast bait.

Do not sell this product in individual containers holding less than four (4) pounds of bait.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where rats or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Protect bait from rain or snow. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

RATS: Open pack and apply 4 to 16 oz. of bait per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days. The amount of bait in this package is unlikely to be sufficient to kill more than one or two rats.

MICE: Apply ¼ to ½ oz. (1-2 level tablespoons) of bait at 8 to 12 –foot intervals. Larger placements (up to 2 oz.) may be needed at points of very high mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days.

FOLLOW-UP: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Using waterproof gloves, collect and dispose of all dead animals and leftover bait properly. To prevent re-infestation, limit sources of rodent food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If re-infestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store only in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Keep containers closed and away from other chemicals.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be placed in trash or delivered to an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Handling: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container.

[Plastic:] Triple rinse (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning; or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill; or incineration.

[Paper:] Dispose of empty container by placing in trash, at an approved waste disposal facility or by incineration.
