

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

Convulsive Poison! Poisonous if swallowed. Do not breathe dust. Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs. Keep away from children, pets and domestic animals. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Clean clothing should be used daily.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Balts exposed on soil surface may be hazardous to birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes.

ENDANGERED SPECIES CONSIDERATIONS

NOTICE: The killing of a member of an endangered species during strychnine baiting operations may result in a fine under the Endangered Species Act. Before baiting, the user is advised to contact the Regional U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (Endangered Species Specialist) or the local Fish and Game Office for specific information on endangered species. Strychnine balts should not be used in the geographic ranges of the following species except under programs and procedures approved by the USEPA: California condor, San Joaquin kit fox, Allen's Canada Goose, Ferris Bay cormorant, salt marsh cormorant, hooded merganser, and glossy ibis.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS

For control of pocket gopher only.

BAITING DIRECTIONS


HAND BAITING

Bait must be placed into pocket gopher runways. Remove burrow plug from the flat side of the burrow fan. Use long-handled spoon and insert one teaspoon of bait into main runway system. Close tunnel with soil in such a manner that soil will not cover bait. One pound of bait will treat five to eight acres.

BAITING ARTIFICIAL BURROW SYSTEMS

When treating extensive areas, "Burrow BaitERS" may be used. Follow manufacturer's instructions for the equipment used to apply gopher bait. Make sure that machine-built burrows intersect gopher burrows at the depth at which gophers have been tunneling. For greatest efficiency of treatment, machine-built burrows should intersect at only gopher tunnels at parallel or right angles. Apply 1 to 2 pounds of bait per acre using a 20' to 30' row spacing interval. Apply only when soil condition is proper to insure formation of a good artificial burrow.

For control of the Northern pocket gopher, *Thomomys talpoides*.
For underground use only in orchards and in alfalfa fields, hayfields, pasture and rangeland and other noncrop areas.



STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store only in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children, pets and domestic animals.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spilled bait, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty bag by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of bags in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: CALL A PHYSICIAN OR POISON CONTROL CENTER IMMEDIATELY:

If less than ten (10) minutes have passed since the poison was taken, give 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have patient lie down in quiet, darkened room and keep him warm and quiet. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED — Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN — Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES — Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

A. Administer 100% OXYGEN by positive pressure to provide as much pulmonary gas exchange as possible, despite seizures.

B. Administer ANTICONVULSANT DRUGS intravenously to control convulsions.

CAUTION: It may be difficult or impossible to stop the seizure activity without stopping respiration. Be prepared to maintain pulmonary ventilation mechanically. Tracheotomy may be necessary if seizures are prolonged.
