DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Paper Mill Slime Control: Add to beaters 0.4 to 1.0 pound of No. 475-C per ton of paper produced.

Preservation of Sizes: For the preservation of paper sizes (cornstarch, dextrine, casein soya protein), use 0.1 to 1.0% of No. 475-C depending upon nature of size.

Slime and Algae Control in Cooling Water Systems: Clean system of debris before starting treatment. Add an initial dose of three (3) pounds of 475-C per 3000 gallons of water in the system. Thereafter, add one (1) pound of 475-C per 3000 gallons of water in the system every week or as needed.
