### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Uniformly spray 2 to 3 gals. per 1,000 sq. ft. of soil surface, undiluted (100 to 120 gal. per acre). Thoroughly wet all foliage to ensure contact action. Best results are obtained

when applications are made during or soon after week emergence when growth is succulent. Where vegetation is tall and dense, use 5 gal. per 1,000 sq. ft. (200 gals. per acre). For control of hard to kill perennial weeds and grasses, such as Johnsongrass, Bardweed, and Wild carrot, use 8 to 12 gals. per 1,000 sq. ft. Although Reliance-Brooks Vegetation Killer has good penetrative activity through foliage, contact with the activity is through the roots and stems. Adequate rainfall to move the chemical into the root zone is necessary.

Under conditions where the vegetation is dense and the growing season long, a second application may be necessary. Do not use this herbicide on lawns, flower beds, vegetable beds, or on the roots of trees, shrubs, or ornamental plants. Do not spray with the nozzle directly on desirable plants. Avoid spray drift to desirable plants.

Do not reuse empty drum. Return to manufacturer or destroy by perforating or crushing and burying in a safe place away from water supplies.
