DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Apply powder liberally to body of animal, working in dust by rubbing against the lay of the hair until dust penetrates to skin. Contact ticks with powder. Repeat once weekly if necessary.

For kennels and living quarters, dust bedding and floor at the rate of one ounce per fifty square feet of surface

Dr. Merrick's SCRATCHEX Powder is for rapid and residual control of fleas and ticks on cats and dogs. It is odorless and non-staining. Contains DRIONE and SLVIN insecticides.

Do not treat kittens or puppies under four weeks of age.
