Fluff the hair as you spray so the spray will penetrate to the skin. The spray should wet the ticks thoroughly. Repeat as needed. Use in pet's sleeping area or on bedding, walls, furniture, floors and carpeting to control reinfestation.

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
