

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its lebeling.

This disinfectant at use dilutions of 1/2 oz. per gallon of water is effective in killing Selmonella choleraesuis on environmental surfaces, and has a pleasing aroma of pine. Use in rest homes, motels, hotels, schools, public buildings.

For best results, clean surface to be disinfected, then map or spray with a solution of 1/2 oz. disinfectant per gallon of water-keep surface wet for at least ten minutes. Warm solutions are more effective.

Use on toilets, urinals, levetories, shower stalls, floors, walls, refrigerators, rubber and plastic surfaces. Force water from toilet bowl through trap, using mop or force cup; pour 1/2 oz. into bowl, mop all surfaces, allow to stand at least ten minutes. Flosh.

Thoroughly rines all surfaces which may come into contact with food.

To deciderize laundry, use 1 conce per sellon of water in next to final rinse after laundering. Rinse.
