For use on pre-cleaned, hard, inanimate surfaces. For heavy soil or organic matter, a pre-cleaning step is required. Rinse with clear water. Apply disinfectant solution of 2 oz. per gallon of water to tollets, restroom floors, shower stalls, diaper pails and garbage cans. Wet all eurlaces thoroughly. Use 4 oz. per gallon of water for sick rooms, hospitals, or clinics. Keep surfaces wet for at least 10 minutes. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.
