### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This disinfection at use dilutions of 1½ oz. per gallon of water is effective in killing *Salmonella choleraesuis* on environmental surfaces, and has a pleasing aroma of pine. Effective against gram negative enteric bacteria.

For best results, clean surface to be disinfected, then mop or spray with a solution of 1½ oz. disinfectant per gallon of water—keep surface wet for at least 10 minutes. For moderately soiled surfaces, use 6 oz. germicide per gallon of water. Use in hotels, motels, schools, office buildings, industrial plants, public transportation.

Use on toilets, urinals, lavatories, shower stalls, floors, walls, refrigerators, rubber and plastic surfaces. Force water from toilet bowl through trap, using mop or force cup; pour 4 oz. into bowl, mop all surfaces, allow to stand at least 10 minutes. Flush.

All treated food contact surfaces e.g. counter top, stoves, and refrigerators must be scrubbed with detergent and rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS WARNING

Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Wear long-sleeve shirt and long pants, socks and shoes, chemical resistant gloves, and goggles or safety glasses. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Remove contaminated clothing before reuse.

### FIRST AID

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

**IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF SWALLOWED:** Call a Poison Control Center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of

water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told by a Poison Control Center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, FOOD, OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL.**  
**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Keep container closed when not in use. Do not store near heat or open flame. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Metal Containers—Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities. Plastic Containers — Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

### GENERAL PRECAUTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

Following application as a low-pressure or high pressure spray, do not enter or allow others to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.

**USER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS:** Follow manufacture's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry. Users should remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Users should remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing.

Do not apply in a way that will contact workers or any other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during the application.
