DIRECTIONS

FOR DISINFECTING. Hold can upright about 6 to 10 inches from surface to be disinfected and spray for three seconds. FOR DEODORIZING: Hold dispenser upright and spray toward ceiling for 6 to 8 seconds in an average size room (10x10). FOR MILDEW: Clean the surface prior to spraying Spray the surface for three seconds. Repeat once a week to inhibit further mildew growth.
