It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This is a heavy duty cleaner and disinfectant designed for general purpose use where heavy duty cleaning is of prime importance. When used as directed, it will remove most dirt and grime in a single, simple application. Follow the Use Directions. Use on walls, floors, table tops and other hard, nonporous surfaces in industrial plants, offices, motels, schools.

To disinfect against Pseudomonas aeruginosa, use 6 ounces per gallon of water for 1 liter (33.8 ounces) per 5 gallons. Clean and disinfect whirlpool equipment using a dilution of 6 ounces per gal-

DISINFECTION: For heavy duty cleaning and disinfecting and fungicidal activity against pathogenic fungi, use 4.5 ounces per gallon of water.
