DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This is a heavy duty cleaner and disinfectant designed for general purpose use where heavy duty cleaning is of prime importance. When used as directed, it will remove most dirt and grime in a single, simple application. Follow the Use Directions. Use on walls, floors, tabletops and other hard, nonporous surfaces in industrial plants, offices, motels, schools.

To disinfect against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, use 6 ounces per gallon of water. Clean and disinfect whirlpool equipment using a dilution of 6 ounces per gallon of water. Minimum contact time - 10 minutes. No rinse required.

DISINFECTION: For heavy duty cleaning and disinfecting and fungicidal activity against pathogenic fungi, use 4.5 ounces per gallon of water. For best results, use a cloth or mop and apply to walls, floors, tabletops, counters, other nonporous surfaces. Thoroughly wet all surfaces. Allow to remain wet for ten minutes and then let air dry.

For light duty cleaning and deodorizing, use 2 ounces per gallon of water. For extra heavy industrial cleaning, use a second application. Do not mix with soap or anionic solutions. This product is noncorrosive in use dilutions on inanimate hard surfaces.

This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant/high level disinfectant on any surface or instrument that (1) is introduced directly into the human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intact mucous membranes but which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. This product may be used to preclean or decontaminate critical or semi-critical medical devices prior to sterilization or high level disinfection.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Keep Out of Reach of Children. Causes skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear gloves when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with food.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash all clothing worn and swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of water. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may be expected. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory distress, etc., may be needed.

ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS

Do not discharge effluent containing this product into streams, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination Act permit. A permitting authority has been notified in writing not to discharge effluent containing this product to navigable waters without notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority and the State Water Board or regional Office of the EPA.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
