Laundered fabric may also be treated and softened by soaking in a solution of CARROLL FABRIC SOFTENER/SANITIZER, for recommended solution concentration, see "Directions for Use."

CARROLL FABRIC SOFTENER/SANITIZER Bacteriostatic Laundry Softener Concentrate is economical to use because it is concentrated. It should be handled with care.

DANGER
