To Kill Carpet Beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever ..... these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

<u>To Kill Fleas and Ticks on Dogs and Cats</u>: Apply directly to animal's back, under forelegs, and other areas except scrotum and anus. Part hair to contact skin and insure good coverage. Hold nozzle about one foot away while spraying. Apply until hair is thoroughly moist. Do not spray directly in eyes or mouth of animal. Repeat within 24 hours of first treatment, if necessary. Note: This aerosol may make a slight hissing sound and cause a temporary cool sensation. Hold pet securely while applying. Nervous animals may become frightened the first time this product is used, but soon become accustomed to the treatment.

<u>To Kill Fleas and Ticks in Pet Bedding and Pet Areas</u>: To reduce reinfestation, thoroughly spray the animal's bedding and other resting places until the surface is slightly moist. Treat these areas at the rate of two seconds per linear foot at a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Also spray the entire inside surface of dog houses. Repeat as necessary.
