

On toilet bowls and urinals: Agitate surface with wetted toilet mop to remove gross filth. Force water from bowl through trap, using mop or force cup. Use flip-top cap and squirt under rim of bowl and around top of urinal. Cleaner will slowly run down sides of fixture coating the entire surface. Let stand 10 minutes, then swab or mop clean and flush.
