- b. Submit the flashpoint and flame extension. *The flash point reported exceeds the one expected for the product.* Please check and resubmit. Mixtures marketed under pressure, including those containing hydrocarbons, are subject in their entirety to tests indicated in 40 CFR 162(h)(2)(iii). (Flashpoints are conveniently measured after collecting the liquid expelled from the container in an open cup chilled with dry ice.)

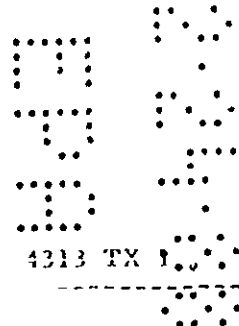

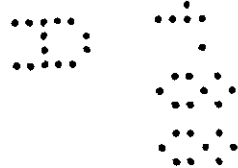
STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame. Do not incinerate empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

This product will kill Cockroaches, Houseflies, Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Small Flying Moths, Fleas, Ticks, Pill Bugs, Crickets.

Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.
