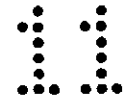

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**  
It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label directions.

This product will kill cockroaches, beetles, crickets, fleas, flies, weevils, saw-toothed grubs, small flying moths, spiders, etc.

Cover exposed food, dishes, and equipment. Open cabinets and drawers to be treated. Shut off fans and turn doors and windows. Point nozzle from face when releasing. Use in 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed space. Additional units for remote rooms. Flow of mist is not assured. Repeat spraying in two weeks before re-entry.

**TO OPERATE VALVE:** Place newspaper or pad on stand in center of the room. Point nozzle from face. To lock valve in automatic discharge, press down, hooking the catch on stand or table with valve building at once and keep two hours before airing out windows and allow to air repeat spraying in two weeks. **TO KILL TICKS AND FLEAS:** old bedding and replace washing after treatment is completed as above. Pets should be treated flea and tick control entering treated premises.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Store in a cool, dry place away from heat or open flame. **DISPOSAL:** and discard container in trash or puncture.
