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c. Under HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS replace the sentence(s) beginning, "Do not use in food/feed areas...and ending...facility is in operation." with "Do not use in commercial food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed."

d. Revise the front panel statement to read "One unit treats 6000 cubic feet (a room 30' x 25' with a 8 foot ceiling)."

e. Under directions delete "use addition units for remote rooms or where xxx etc."

f. At the end of TO KILL TICKS AND FLEAS: add the following precautions: IMPORTANT! To avoid FLAMMABILITY HAZARD, use can as follows: Only one can per room. Do not place in cabinet or under counter or table. Shut off electrical equipment. Place can at least 6 feet from pilot light.

For more information regarding flammability labeling concerns for total release fogger pesticides see the Federal register dated April 15, 1994 (50 FR 18058).

3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** Shake well before use. Keep container tightly closed. Do not use in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product will kill cockroaches, beetles, crickets, fleas, houseflies, weevils, saw-toothed grain beetles, flying moths, spiders, ticks and mites.

Cover exposed food, dishes and equipment. Open cabinets and doors. Shut off fans and air conditioning. Turn off pilot lights. Close windows. Point valve opening away from building. Release fogger. Use one unit for each 600 cubic foot unobstructed area. Use additional units in rooms or where free flow of mist is not desired. Do not reenter area until fog has cleared. Do not remain in the area during treatment. Shake well before reentry.

**TO OPERATE VALVE:** Place several sheets of paper or pad on stand or table in front of fogger. Point valve opening away from face. Turn valve in open position for automatic release. Push valve button all the way down, hold down. Then place fogger on stand or table. Turn valve to locked open. Leave building at once. Do not reenter until fog has cleared. Close doors and windows and allow to aerate. Repeat spraying in 2 weeks or when necessary.

**TO KILL TICKS AND FLEAS:** Use fogger in bedding and replace with clean bedding after treatment is completed. Use fogger on pets. Pets should be treated with a registered flea control product prior to reentering.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

**DISPOSAL:** Replace cap and dispose in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
