APPLICATIONS

AROCIDE B is used to inhibit the growth of algae, bacteria, and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial cooling water systems. Before treatment with AROCIDE B systems must be cleaned to remove algal growth, microbiological slime, and other deposits. Then the system should be treated with an initial slug addition of 6.0 to 13.0 fluid ounces of AROCIDE B per 1,000 gallons of water in the system. Repeat the initial dosage until control is evident. Subsequent slug additions of 2.3 to 13.0 fluid ounces of AROCIDE B per 1,000 gallons of water should be made every 1 to 5 days or as needed. The required frequency of treatment depends on the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the microbiological problem. Slug additions of AROCIDE B should be made to the sump of water cooling towers.

WARNING

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

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For best results, clean surface to be disinfected, then mix or spray with solution of 2 ounces disinfectant per gallon of water. Keep surface wet for at least 10 minutes. For moderately soiled surfaces, use 1 ounce per gallon of water. For heavily soiled surfaces, use 2 ounces per gallon of water. Warm solutions are more effective.
