#### DIRECTIONS FOR PREPARING SANITIZING SOLUTIONS

Solution No. 1 (200 ppm  
active) 1/500 Stir 1 oz  
SANICIDE in 4 gal. water.

Solution No. 2 (400 ppm  
active) 1/250 Stir 1 oz  
SANICIDE in 1 gal. water.

Solution No. 3 (600 ppm  
active) 1/125 Stir 1 oz  
SANICIDE in 1 gal. water.

Two tablespoons = 1 oz.

Test: Use Stone-Marshall  
test papers as directed  
to test strength of  
sanitizing sol'n in use.
