Directions for use: To wash the bathtub, basin, and toilet, apply in a one-to-forty dilution in water.

In Public Places: Schools, hotels, theatres, stores, office buildings, colleges, etc. spray freely with one part to forty parts of water.

In Garbage Receptacles: To aid in the prevention of breeding of flies, spray the receptacles and garbage daily with a one-to-twenty-five dilution in water.
