DIRECTIONS

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

Alkyl (C ₈ -8%, C ₁₀ -7%, C ₁₂ -48%, C ₁₄ -17%, C ₁₆ -9%, C ₁₈ -11%) dimethylbenzyl ammonium chloride	5%
Bis (tributyltin) oxide	2%
Inert ingredients	93%

WHEN USING STOCK SOLUTION

Mix 1 part MOLDEX to 4 parts water
Use 1 to 2 quarts per 300 to 400 lb. load
Add with sour and run 3 to 5 minutes

WHEN USING CONCENTRATED SOLUTION

Use 2 ounces MOLDEX per 100 lb. load
Add with sour and run 3 to 5 minutes
