

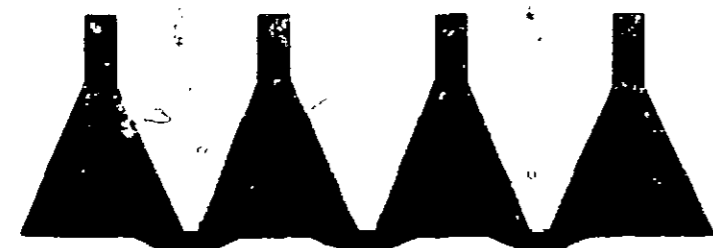

Phenol Coefficient 5 by A. O. A. C. Method

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS: Soap, isopropanol, sodium ortho-benzyl-para-chlorophenate, pine oil28%
INERT INGREDIENTS72%
Water, tetrasodium ethylene-diamine tetraacetate, sodium sulfite

CAUTION:

Keep Out of the Reach of Children

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, and clothing. In case of contact, wash profusely with cold water. If irritation persists, get medical attention. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

DIRECTIONS

Use 3 oz. **PINE-O-CIDE** to gallon of lukewarm water. Prepare solution by pouring **PINE-O-CIDE** into pail first, then add water and stir well. Do not use in boiling water. Solution can be applied by mop or wash cloth. Allow 10-15 minutes contact time before rinsing disinfectant solution. Heavy soil deposits should be removed before applying disinfecting solution.
