## DIRECTIONS:

Rinse oil treated utensils and surfaces with clean potable water to remove all traces of LAN-ODYNE before reuse.

FOR UDDERS: Use individual clean towels for each udder washing. Never dip used towel back into solution and always use fresh solution of 1/2 oz. LAN-ODYNE to 10 quarts of lukewarm water at 90° F. (provides 25 ppm titratable iodine).

CLEANING OPERATIONS: **Immediately** after each milking, thoroughly flush all utensils and milking machines with cold or lukewarm water until all milk is washed out. **Do not use hot water.**

Fill wash tank with water at 90° F. to which is added 1 ounce of LAN-ODYNE for each 5 gallons water (provides 25 ppm titratable iodine). Take milking machines apart and immerse parts in LAN-ODYNE solution before brushing. Wash pails and strainers in same solution.

SANITIZING OPERATIONS: Make LAN-ODYNE solution of 1 ounce to each 5 gallons lukewarm water. Immerse washed utensils for 2 minutes. **Before** each milking assemble and flush machines with LAN-ODYNE solution of 1/2 ounce LAN-ODYNE to 10 quarts cold water.
