RECOMMENDED PROCEDURES

FLOORS AND WALLS: To clean and sanitize--
 1. Remove loose soil by dry-mop or vacuum.
 2. Apply solution liberally and scrub with mop or machine. (The longer solution remains on surface, better the 'kill'.)
 3. Pick-up soiled solution.
 4. Rinse with clear water if soil condition warrants.
 5. For additional sanitizing, follow with application of fresh solution--do not rinse.

RECEPTACLES AND EQUIPMENT:
 To clean and sanitize, use 1 : 200 solution.
